A list of monsters

Bubbler – This monster is covered in skin like a crocodile's, and when its skin starts bubbling, run as fast as you can. The bubbles will burst open in about one minute, and there is acid underneath. It will come out and dissolve you in seconds unless you run away. The bubbler is not hurt by the acid, and it can spray acid multiple times. My personal advice would be to run away no matter whether its skin is bubbling or not. Bubblers are the same shape as humans, and they are light green in color.

Tentaclo – This monster is purple and it looks like a squid, but out of the water and with longer tentacles. Try to stay out of the reach of its tentacles, because it will try to strangle you to death with them.

Slimer – This monster is human shaped, and made out of a sticky, slimy substance. If you chop it in half with a sword, it will turn into two of them. The only way to kill it is to use water, because slimers have a similar effect from water as humans have to acid. That's right: they dissolve. Slimers do not kill their victims, but they can fire sticky slime from their fingers and they use it to stick their victims to the ground. Then it leaves them there, and they stay there until someone comes to free them. However, the slime is so sticky that often they do no more than get stuck themselves.

Magma orb – This monster is a floating sphere made of lava. Nobody knows how it works, but it seems to have a mind of its own. They have been seen chasing cars, starting

fires and even burning down whole villiages. We don't know how to kill them yet, but we are working on it. It seems that these mysterious beings do not reproduce, but they form under certain conditions.

Battering bird – These monsters look exactly like seagulls but they are more aggressive. As soon as they see a human, they will ram them with their beaks, which seem to be made out of something stronger and heavier than the beak of an ordinary seagull. Battering birds also fly five times as fast as a seagull, so there is no running away from this one. One ram is enough to make a human unconscious. However, these birds don't like the smell of rotten fish, and we have recently been hanging rotten fish outside houses in some villiages where battering bird raids are more common. It seems to have worked and the birds do not come anywhere near those villiages anymore. However, they still attack people travelling from one villiage to another. Some people carry rotten fish with them for the journey, but horse riders complain that their horses don't like the smell either.

Bug bomb – This strange creature looks exactly like an ordinary beetle, but if you get too close to it, it explodes. They travel in huge swarms that range from a thousand to a million beetles in each. The explosion of one bug bomb is no big deal and doesn't do much damage, but swarms have a habit of all exploding at the same time, which usually does enough damage to make a house fall down.
